Starlites Competitive Dance Teams Are National Dance Champs Once Again!

The Starlites Competitive Dance teams from the Huron Physical Arts Center competed Friday, Saturday and Sunday, April 13th thru 15th at the Showcase America Unlimited National Dance Championships. This National competition is held annually at the Greater Columbus Convention Center, Columbus, Ohio. Over 100 teams competed for National titles.

The **Starlites Primary** team were named Gold Medal National Champions in the pom category. They also placed 1st in the Primary Jazz division. They were the only Primary team to receive Superior ratings for both routines. They also were awarded the High Technique and High General Effect Awards for their pom routine. The Primary Officer Line received a Superior rating and the Silver Medal for their performance of "Do You Believe in Magic".

The **Starlites Elementary** team placed 2nd in the jazz category and 1st in the lyrical category, receiving Superior ratings for both routines. The Elementary Officer Line, dancing to "Wild Child", received a Superior rating, placing 2nd overall in the Elementary Officer Line category, receiving the Silver Medal.

The **Starlites Elementary Combined** team placed 1st in the pom and hip hop categories, receiving Superior ratings for both routines. Their pom routine was awarded the High Technique Award. The team also received the Silver Medal for their pom routine.

The **Starlites Junior** team placed 1st in the jazz category, 2nd in lyrical and 4th in pom, receiving Superior ratings for all routines. The Junior Officer Line, performing to a "Country Gal Mix" received Superior rating and the Bronze Medal.

The **Starlites Senior** team placed 1st in the pom category, 3rd in lyrical and 6th in jazz. They received Superior ratings for all routines as well as the High Technique award for their pom routine. They were awarded the Gold Medal for their pom routine, Senior High Division. The Senior Officer Line, dancing to "Oh So Quiet", placed 2nd overall, receiving the Silver Medal and a Superior rating.

The **Starlites Senior Combined Hip Hop** team placed 6th overall, in the Senior High large division, receiving a Superior rating.

The teams are coached by Kelly Higgins and Christie Charron. Director is Lynne Hearn and Executive Director is Laurie Charron, owner of the Huron Physical Arts Center.
